Process

Eligibility Check	STP Staff will carry out initial checks to ensure applications have been completed correctly, have confirmed match and are eligible to apply
Initial Assessment	STP Staff will perform an initial assessment against the agreed criteria, geographic spread, and make an interim recommendation to the Assessment Panel
Panel Assessment	<p>The Assessment Panel will score applications from 1 to 5 (1 poor, 5 excellent).
